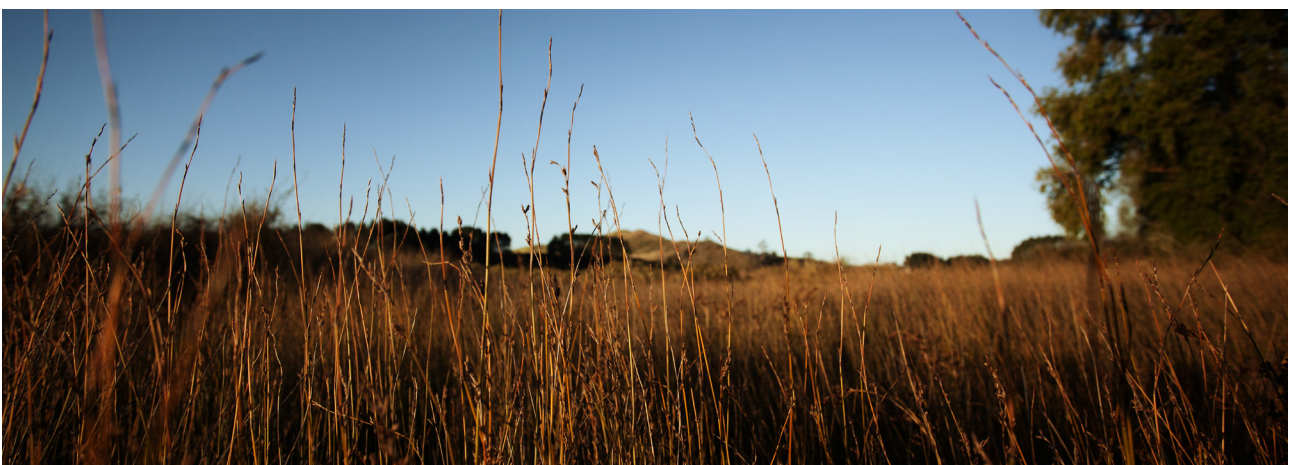
The other exciting piece kicking off this week is the next Expression of Interest process for housing opportunities in Manawa and we have more detail about that below.
