INSTRUCTIONS:

1. You can vote by returning this voting paper to the Chief Returning Officer at the Annual General Meeting of Ngā Pōtiki ā Tamapahore Trust, which is scheduled for Saturday March 4 2023, 10am at Club Mount Maunganui. Alternatively, you can return your voting paper via post, or via email (as outlined below).
2. There are eight (8) nominees seeking election to fill the three (3) contestable positions on the board of trustees. **You can only vote for/tick up to three (3) nominees.** Only registered members 18 years old or over are eligible to vote.
3. To make a postal vote, tick up to three (3) nominees, fill in your registered member number, cut along the dotted line, and place the bottom portion of this page in the enclosed freepost envelope provided.
